



## SOCIO-ECONOMIC DATA

## SLOVENIJA, LOVRENC NA POHORJU

**Slovenia** is mostly mountainous and forested, covers 20,271 square kilometres, and has a population of 2.1 million (2,108,708 people). <u>Slovenes</u> constitute over 80% of the country's population.

With 101 inhabitants per square kilometer, Slovenia ranks low among the European countries in population density (compared to 402/km² for the Netherlands or 195/km² for Italy). Between 65% and 79% of people live in wider urban areas.

Slovenia is among the European countries with the most pronounced ageing of its population, ascribable to a low birth rate and increasing life expectancy.

**Slovenian Styria** (*Slovenska Štajerska*) is a traditional region in northeastern <u>Slovenia</u>. The population of Styria in its historical boundaries amounts to around 705,000 inhabitants, or 34.5% of the population of Slovenia. The largest city is <u>Maribor</u>.

The **City Municipality of Maribor**, is one of <u>city municipalities</u> in <u>Slovenia</u>. Its seat is <u>Maribor</u>, the second-largest city in Slovenia. The population of the municipality was 113,778 in January 2021.


**Lovrenc na Pohorju** is a municipality on Pohorje, the mountains at the foot of the Alps:



The municipality spreads over 0,4 % of the whole area of Slovenia and here live 0,1 % citizents of Slovenia. The municipality is among the lowest in Slovenia in population density. People here earn 13,7 % less than other citizens of Slovenia. The number of inhabitants decreases.

















In 2019, 23 % of the population in the Lovrenc na Pohorju municipality was aged 65 or over and 14 % was under 16.









Average age of inhabitants in Lovrenc na Pohorju is incresing (similarly as in Slovenia). The reasons are mostly due to lower birth rate and migrations of inhabitants. They find better jobs in bigger cities. Typical for the municipality is also the high age of male and female in comparison to Slovenia.




